DEMOLITION OF THE MLK BUILDING

Beginning on April 7, 2014, the first phase of demolition for the LRC Building will begin. This preparation phase is expected to last a few weeks with the major phase of the demolition process beginning Monday, April 21, 2014 and ending at or around Friday, May 16, 2014.

The major phase is expected to be noisy and possibly disruptive to the areas surrounding the demolition site. The noise generated has been compared to that of a jet engine with pronounced vibrations expected near the demolition area. Work will begin at 7:00 a.m. and end at 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, until the work is complete.

The construction teams will tarp the east and south sides of the administration building and water down the surrounding areas in order to keep dust within the construction zone. If there are any additional modifications that need to be done to any of areas near the MLK building, we will alert you promptly to any changes.
