ABOUT

Los Angeles City College offers financial assistance in the form of grants, work-study, loans, and scholarships. The financial assistance makes it possible for individuals to afford the cost of attendance at a two-year community college.



FEDERAL AID

- Federal Pell Grant Up to \$6,195 awarded to full-time undergraduate students
- Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG) – Up to \$500 awarded to the most needy students
- Iraq and Afghanistan Service Grant Awarded to students whose parent or guardian was a member of the U.S. armed forces and died as a result of military service performed in Iraq or Afghanistan after the events of 9/11 as Federal Work-Study – paid part-time jobs on campus
- Federal Direct Subsidized Loans Loans whose interest is paid for by the government while the student is enrolled at least half-time (6 or more units)
- Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loans Loans whose interest is paid for by the student
- Federal Direct PLUS Loans loans made by the parents of dependent undergraduate students

STATE AID

- Cal Grant B Entitlement Up to \$1,672 for books and living expenses
- Cal Grant C Entitlement Awards of up to \$547 to help pay for tuition and training costs at occupational or career technical schools
- Cal Grant B Competitive Awards For students with a minimum 2.0 GPA who are from disadvantaged and low-income families
- **Student Services Completion Grant** A supplemental grant to provide students with additional financial aid to encourage full-time attendance and successful on-time completion

HIGHLIGHTS

- Los Angeles City College awarded \$34 million in financial assistance during the 2018-2019 award year.
- Part-time employment under the Federal Work-Study program
