ABOUT

The mission of the **Transfer Center** is to meet the needs of students preparing to transfer to a four-year college or university by providing accurate, up-to-date information and a set of coordinated resources, activities, and services that support the transfer process.

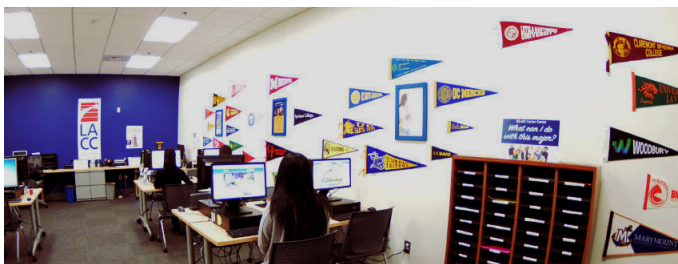
LACC provides students with personalized counseling to receive up-to-date information on transfer requirements, as well as develop educational plans that satisfy transfer requirements. Four-year university admissions representatives make visits to the Center on a regular basis to provide up-to-date transfer information to prospective transfer students, as well as meet with students individually by appointment. Guidance on the transfer process, admissions requirements and procedures, financial aid, majors, and/or on transfer opportunities is available on a walk-in basis. In addition, assistance with university admissions application is available when the application filling period is open for prospective transfer students. Workshops on various transfer topics and field trips to universities are offered each semester. The Center also organizes an annual Transfer Day event every fall term.



HIGHLIGHTS

- UC Riverside admitted 68 students for Fall 18 term
- CSUDH admitted 84 students for Fall 18 term.
- UCLA admitted 64 students for Fall 18 term.
- 286 LACC students applied to UC system schools for Fall 2017 term compared to 302 LACC students that applied for Fall 2018 term
- A student of ours received the Presidential Scholars Award. This is the highest and most distinguished award for a transfer student.
- “Undocumented student” was admitted to the Theatre program. It is not often that this program admits transfer students.
- Several of our LACC students have been admitted to USC to pursue majors in Mathematics, Communication Studies, Civil Engineering, & International Relations to name a few.
- Associates Degree for Transfer: 22 ADT’s were conferred for December 2017 & 164 are in-progress to be conferred in June once SP 18’ term concludes. It’s an estimated number & is subject to change if students complete coursework in-progress and/or additional students submit graduation petitions, which they have until June 4.
