WHY: The LACC 5-week Summer Animation Bootcamp was open to all LA County high school students interested in learning about animation while also earning 6 transferrable college course credits. The bootcamp allowed students to experience college for the first time and learn about the process of making an animated short film, create character designs, storyboards, 3D modeling, editing, sound design and more. The cohort is made up of 48 students, 40 of which are LAUSD students.
