Entry-Level Job Sites for College Graduates

Over half of entry-level jobs require at least three years of experience. It's a catch-22 for graduates with little or no experience who are looking for a job. A good place to start your job search is looking for entry-level opportunities.

Here are some good job websites for college graduates:

Indeed

Founded in 2004, Indeed is the largest job website in the world. They average 10 new job listings added per second. Job seekers can find open entry-level positions in a wide variety of industries including healthcare, marketing, finance, real estate, sales and many other fields. To find entry-level positions, type in your desired job title and industry and add "entry level" or "junior." You can also select "entry level" from the dropdown menu under the "experience level" filter. Indeed is a free service and includes a salary search tool and company reviews.

CollegeGrad

Created in 1995, CollegeGrad is the number one entry-level job site for recent alumni. It has fewer listings than Indeed but is specifically tailored for college graduates. Type in your location and desired role and check the box that says "entry level." You can also create an account to customize job alerts. CollegeGrad is a free service.

FlexJobs

Founded in 2007, FlexJobs offers a variety of work-from-home opportunities. It is largest site for remote jobs, including more than 30,000 listings. FlexJobs is not free and has a monthly charge of \$24.95 or a \$59.95 charge for a yearlong membership. Membership also includes discounts on products and services including tax software, laptops and career coaching.

LinkedIn

Launched in 2002, LinkedIn is the largest professional networking platform. It serves as a database to post a digital resume and offers social networking and job opportunities. Your LinkedIn profile serves as a public digital resume and will be sent to recruiters once you apply for a job. It's free to upload a profile, search opportunities and grow your network. LinkedIn also offers a premium membership where members can view who has looked at your profile and provides detailed information on other applicants.
