In July 2022, the "Free Community College For All" bill extended the California College Promise Program. Now all returning full-time and first-time students can attend community colleges completely tuition free.

At LACC, we provide a comprehensive strategy to support our students in completing a higher education degree and/or workforce certificate.

Highlights of the Promise program include:

- Waived tuition for two-years of full-time college
- Priority enrollment
- A dedicated support team providing a wide array of academic and student support services
- Additional financial support to assist with transportation, books or food
- A free laptop and Wi-Fi connectivity
- Access to emergency aid funds

The Promise program is designed to prepare students for academic success and to help students in selecting the career path that is right for them.

MetaCity Program at LACC

LACC recently launched its Summer/Fall 2022 MetaCity academy, with 46 additional employees joining the program resulting in 100 LACC faculty and staff who are creating accessible, virtual reality learning experiences.

The MetaCity Program enables LACC faculty and students to use augmented (AR), virtual (VR) and mixed (MR) reality in new and engaging ways through the creation of virtual experiences that can mitigate learning barriers in a variety of fields, including STEM courses, medical simulations, and tech education while also increasing hands-on learning and student success.

The classes provide a variety of benefits for students and professors, including the ability to reinforce and enhance content originally delivered live or in an online lecture; provide students with hands-on experiences; better convey 3D concepts; enable students to apply critical thinking to realistic occupational scenarios; and enable students to view objects, internal components, and scenarios they otherwise would not have access to.

MetaCity instructors have created AR/VR/MR lessons in more than 30 disciplines including English, Mathematics, Chemistry, Dental Technology, College Counseling, Anatomy, Electronics, History, Microbiology, Music, and more.
