Family Reunification (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Sat, Jan 7, 2022, 10 am – 1 pm	Denetra Norwood	How to prepare a child when is time to go back home? Discussion on how Resource Parents can support the process of family reunification and working in partnership with the birth family.
Solutions (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Tue, Jan 10, 2022, 5:30 – 8:30 pm	Rob Hanna	This workshop is used to help educate the foster parents on the importance of love and understanding. Coming up with logical solutions on how to assist the child on their everyday tasks.
Higher Education Module 1 (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Fri, Jan 13, 2022, 6:00 – 9:00 pm	Sharonda Barksdale	Mandatory training. The purpose of this module is to empower caregivers to discuss the value of higher education with their youth and provide ideas for how they can play an active role in supporting their youth to college. For caregivers with youth in middle school or in the early high school grades, college can seem so far into the future that it can take secondary importance to more immediate concerns. Caregivers will learn the significance of early college exploration and preparation and key steps that they can take to help youth turn their dreams into degrees
Special Care Increment (SCI) Training (Formerly known as D & F-rate training)	Jan 17, 18, and 19, 2022 5:00pm – 9:00pm **YOU MUST ATTEND ALL 3 SESSIONS**	Sandra Smith	The Special Care Increment (SCI)Training is the 12 hours foundational training for resource parents who are caring for children, adolescents and non-minor dependents who require specialized care resulting in resource parents going above and beyond the basic level of care (LOC) to meet a child's health, physical, emotional, behavioral, educational, permanency and family service needs. This training covers an overview and explanation of LOC & SCI, substance use, medication and behavior management, the impact of trauma on development, navigating the educational system, birth parent engagement, self-care and resources for successful SCI placement.
What to Know About Psychotropic Medications (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Fri, Jan 20, 2022, 5:30 – 8:30 pm	Sandra Smith	This workshop is to teach parents about Psychotropic Meds and the effects they cause. Teaching them the different meds and the purpose of their usage.

Recognizing and Preventing Child Neglect (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Wed, Jan 27, 2022, 5:30 – 8:30 pm	Sandra Smith	Neglect occurs when a child's physical, emotional, educational, and medical needs are not met. See what behaviors may lead to neglect, and learn what happens when parents and caregivers fail to provide for their children. In this class students will find out where to turn for help, and how to foster a healthy parent/child relationship.
Understanding Feelings and Behaviors (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Sat, Jan 28, 2022, 10 am – 1 pm	Rob Hanna	The way that a child manifests his/her feelings is through their behavior. This workshop will focus on feelings and behaviors, and how to work with children to make them feel safe and secure, so they can open up and communicate their feelings. Behaviors will be discussed, and what they can really mean instead of labeling a child as a child who is always "acting up."
Dealing with Meltdowns and Tantrums (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Tue, Jan 31, 2022, 5:30 – 8:30 pm	Denetra Norwood	Many children have temper tantrums and meltdowns. Is there a difference?  What are the causes? What should a parent do when this happens? In this class we will look at the difference between a temper tantrum and a meltdown.  We will also discuss the causes, how to understand them, and how to manage them.
