Navigating DCFS, the Courts, and Permanency (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Fri, June 2, 2023, 6 – 9 pm	Sharonda Barksdale	Navigating the system can be confusing. This workshop will provide you with knowledge and tools on how to navigate the system including DCFS, and the court.
Special Care Increment (SCI) Training (Formerly known as D & F-rate training)	June 5, 6 and 7, 2023 5:00pm – 9:00pm **YOU MUST ATTEND ALL 3 SESSIONS**	Sandra Smith	The Special Care Increment (SCI) Training is the 12 hours foundational training for resource parents who are caring for children, adolescents and non-minor dependents who require specialized care resulting in resource parents going above and beyond the basic level of care (LOC) to meet a child's health, physical, emotional, behavioral, educational, permanency and family service needs. This training covers an overview and explanation of LOC & SCI, substance use, medication and behavior management, the impact of trauma on development, navigating the educational system, birth parent engagement, self-care and resources for successful SCI placement.
Self-Injury: Thoughts and Behaviors (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Sat, June 10, 2023, 10 am – 1 pm	Sharonda Barksdale	In this class, caregivers will learn what are non-suicidal self-injurious behaviors. We will explore how trauma impacts SI behaviors. Caregivers will also be provided with tips and resources for working with youth who exhibit NSSI behaviors.
Sexual Abuse: What is It? How Do We Respond? (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Tue, June 13, 2023 5:30 – 8:30 pm	Rob Hanna	Understanding what sexual abuse is. How to recognize some symptoms and signs, and what are some anger-related behaviors, sexualized behaviors, and fear & anxiety behaviors that children might display. Also, how us as resource parents we can help out our children heal through "therapeutic parenting."
Eating Disorders (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	Wed, June 13, 2023 5:30 – 8:30 pm	Denetra Norwood	Teaching the parents how to deal with foster children with poor eating skills whether they are starving themselves or being a glutton. Both of these disorders are dangerous to the child's health. The parents are taught how to handle different situations and are directed to what is necessary to help the child.
Keeping Fathers Involved (Renewal for RFA, W)	Tue, June 20, 2023 5:30 – 8:30 pm	Rob Hanna	This class will discuss how we can have more male role models in the lives of children and the importance of fathers being involved in the parenting of children. Promoting father involvement is part of the state's plan to improve children's well-being and reduce the risk factors associated with a lack of fatherhood involvement. Participants will understand the importance of fatherhood, understand the relationship between fathers and children in the child welfare system, and develop effective methods for fathers to spend time with their children.
Parenting Styles and the Message They Send (Renewal for RFA, W)	Tue, June 20, 2023 5:30 – 8:30 pm	Rob Hanna	This workshop is to teach parents the different styles of parenting and how to know which style works for them.

For caregivers with youth in middle school or in the early high school grades, college can seem so far into the future that it can take secondary importance to more immediate concerns. Caregivers will learn the significance of early college exploration and preparation and key steps that they can take to help youth turn their dreams into degrees
