Special Care Increment (SCI) Training (Formerly known as D & F rate training)	October 2, 3, 4, 2023, 5pm-9pm **YOU MUST ATTEND ALL THREE SESSIONS**	Sandra Smith	The Special Care Increment (SCI) Training is the 12 hours foundational training (which replaces the D & F rate pre-service training) for resource parents who are caring for children, adolescents and non-minor dependents who require specialized care resulting in resource parents going above and beyond the basic level of care (LOC) to meet a child's health, physical, emotional, behavioral, educational, permanency and family service needs. This training covers an overview and explanation of LOC & SCI, substance use, medication and behavior management, the impact of trauma on development, navigating the educational system, birth parent engagement, self-care and resources for successful SCI placement.
A Different Kind of Mind: Dyslexia (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	October 6, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Denetra Norwood	This training is designed to bring awareness and focus to caregivers on how to deal with dyslexic children that might come into their homes. Class will start by defining what is "dyslexia" and there types. Participants will understand how to identify the many signs of the disorder as well as how to provide a safe environment as they develop.
Heart 2 Heart (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	October 9, 2023, 5:00pm-9:00pm	Sandra Smith	This workshop will focus on important facts about sexual health risk with youth. Stages of development of adolescence. Building trust and strong relationship with youth. How does trauma affect youth. In addition sex with youth who are LGBTIA. By discuss sex and relationships early and often can decrease risky sexual behaviors. It also promotes healthy behaviors.
Rebuilding Self-Esteem (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	October 11, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Rob Hanna	How to help A child that has experienced abuse or neglect and has been removed from their home rebuild their self-esteem? This class will focus on how Resource Parents can help children and youth work on their self-esteem and self-confidence.
Sexual Abuse: What is it? How Do We Respond? (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	October 13, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Rob Hanna	Understanding what sexual abuse is. How to recognize some symptoms and signs, and what are some anger-related behaviors, sexualized behaviors, and fear & anxiety behaviors that children might display. Also, how us as resource parents we can help out our children heal through "therapeutic parenting."
Prudent Parenting Standards (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	October 16, 2023, 5:00pm-8:00pm	Sandra Smith	What is Prudent Parenting? and what does the law says regarding what you can do with your out-of-home care child? This workshop will address issues related to prudent parenting standards; what you can/can't do; how to protect yourself; and more.
Grief and Loss (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	October 18, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Denetra Norwood	This class will help caregivers understand the grief and loss process. How children may act when confronted be stages of grief. To explore how grief and loss affect our own lives and how we can help our children to process their losses. This workshop will particular focus on what happens when a child goes through multiple placements, and the impact this has on the child; as every move is a trauma for them.
Higher Education Module 1	October 20, 2023, 6pm-9pm	Sharonda Barksdale	The purpose of this module is to empower caregivers to discuss the value of higher education with their youth and provide ideas for how they can play an active role in supporting their youth to college. For caregivers with youth in middle school or in the

Caregivers will learn the significance of early college exploration and preparation and key steps that they can take to help youth turn their dreams into degrees
The Basics on Child Development (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	October 27, 2023, 6pm-9pm	Sharonda Barksdale	This class is designed to bring awareness on the first five years of a child's life and how important their development is. Class will start by defining and identifying stages of development with focuses on the primary developmental domains including physical, intellectual, language, and social/emotional skills. Participants will understand how to provide a safe and caring environment for all children needing the same support and guidance as they develop.
Identifying Suicidal Behavior (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	October 30, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Rob Hanna	Children and youth that have experienced severe trauma are at risk of having self-injurious behaviors, including suicide. What are some of the behaviors that as caregivers we should be paying attention to? What do you do if your child is having suicidal behaviors?
