Adult Dual Enrollment (ADE) / SB554 is a state law that enables students that are enrolled in a High School Diploma or Equivalency program to simultaneously take up to 11 units of credit courses tuition free. To qualify, students must **not** have a high school diploma (including a foreign high school diploma) or its equivalent. Students must be enrolled and remain enrolled in a GED preparation coursework every semester they intend to participate in Adult Dual Enrollment. They **must** also have an initial meeting with a Noncredit counselor to complete an initial educational plan and the Adult Dual Enrollment Form.

By signing this contract, you agree to **NOT** enroll in credit courses until the ADE form is **approved** by the Admissions Office. If your ADE form is denied and you still desire to take credit courses, you may do so, however you will be responsible for the tuition balance.
