Medical Coding & Billing Series

According to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), the projection of growth and demand for medical coders and billers is growing rapidly. With the skill set you will obtain in this series, you will be prepared to sit for the license exam for a national certification with AAPC (which issues the CPC license - Certified Professional Coder) or AHIMA (which issues the CCS license - Certified Coding Specialist).

So if you're interested in working with a doctor's office, clinic or healthcare facility, dental office, insurance company, or independent billing company, LACC Extension's Medical Insurance Series is a great place to start your career or expand on your skills!

Part 1: Medical Terminology

To work in healthcare, knowing medical terminology and having the ability to communicate with physicians, dentists, and other medical professionals is a must. Learning medical terminology will open the door to many job opportunities in the healthcare field. Students in this course will receive thorough instruction in developing fluency with medical terms covering the different body systems, body orientation, diseases, and medical treatments. By the end of this course, you will be familiar with word components for quick mastery of countless medical terms and be able to communicate effectively with peers in the field.

Part 2: Medical Insurance Coding

In physician practice it is common for the Medical Biller to also be the Medical Coder because physicians depend on the Biller/Coder to determine the diagnostic codes for procedures. In this class, learn how to find the proper procedure (CPT-4) and diagnostic codes (ICD-10), how to do proper code sequencing, and when to use these codes.

Prerequisite: Medical Terminology or experience in the medical field.

Required Books: *ICD-10-CM (any publisher) CPT (published by American Medical Association). Old editions accepted if for practice only. Purchase 2024 editions if you are taking the license exam in 2024. No class Aug 31.*

This class will give you a look into the differences between insurance policies and insurance companies, how to fill out forms required for billing, how to handle patients, and collect their payments. **Prerequisites: Medical Terminology & Medical Insurance Coding. Become a Notary Public or Renew Your Commission

All prospective notaries must complete a course approved by the California Secretary of State. Our approved course will give you the most updated notary information and the knowledge you need to pass the state exam and perform your duties correctly. Becoming a notary and notary loan signing agent can be a great way to earn extra money, start your own business, or enhance your current career. Class fee includes a valuable 70-page manual, the ability to take the State Exam after the class (in-person classes only) notary public handbook, certificate of completion, notary public application and sample forms notaries use every day.

Before signing up for this class, check to see that you meet eligibility requirements for becoming a notary: visit <https://www.sos.ca.gov/notary/qualifications>

State examination is conducted on the same day immediately after class starting at 4:30PM.

Bring an official photo ID, two #2 pencils, a 2"x2" passport-sized color photo and a separate \$40 check made payable to the "Secretary of State." You must register with a valid email address. Due to strict State regulations, no one is admitted after class begins. Check-in begins at 7:30AM. Have your current, official photo ID ready.

Notary Loan Signing Seminar

A Notary Signing Agent is a notary public who has specialized expertise in the handling of mortgage loan documents. With the housing market on the rebound, this will be an in-demand service for notary publics! Currently, Notary Signing Agents can make anywhere from \$90-\$180 and more per loan package. Class fee includes valuable 60-page manual (a list of potential sources for your business is included in your manual) a practice loan package, practice journal page, notary forms and the certificate of class completion.

In this six-hour seminar, receive hands-on instruction in the main documents a Notary Signing Agent will notarize. Students may request an Award of Completion for any LACC Extension class for just \$10. Students must have 90% or better attendance to be eligible.

LACC Extension and Los Angeles City College do not certify quality of work done nor competencies gained within our offerings unless specifically delineated. Some offerings lead to separate certification of competency or offer credentials from entities separate from LACC and the LACCD, and are specifically noted.

Room Assignments

Due to ongoing construction, campus renovations, and other factors, LACC Extension has limited access to facilities. Rooms will typically be assigned by the college 1-2 days prior to the start of class. We appreciate your patience and will notify students via the phone and/or email information provided at registration as soon as possible.
