This course examines fundamental concepts that are the building blocks for data science work, include gathering and summarizing data (descriptive statistics) and relationships between variables, probability techniques, and distributions such as conditional probability and Bayes Theorem, and hypothesis testing to facilitate decision-making (inferential statistics).
