All About the CSU

The California State University system is a very large, high-quality public university system known for its affordability and flexible class offerings. There are 23 CSU campuses across the state of California. This session will cover various aspects of the CSU focusing on transfer preparation.

Transfer Portfolio

What is a Transfer Portfolio? A portfolio, simply put, is a collection. If speaking about a financial portfolio, this would include stocks, bonds, and other investments. If speaking about an art portfolio, this would be a collection of work the artist has created. This session will highlight various documents a transfer student should generate, create, or obtain in order to make their transfer experience and the completion of their baccalaureate degree a seamless and beneficial experience.

Transferring to a Private or Out-of-State Institution

There are many things to consider when transferring. But transferring to a private or out-of-state institution adds a different dimension. There are no articulation agreements, there may be non-resident

tuition, there are different application deadlines, different applications, etc. If you are considering any of these institutions, attend this session.
